A WARM WELCOME FROM GLASGOW...

The last time Glasgow hosted the BPNA conference was in the year 2000, when Glasgow's very own Sameer Zuberi was one of the MacKeith prize winners. He was awarded the prize for his ground-breaking research into channelopathies. We look forward to welcoming you back to Glasgow again, 26 years later.

Sitting on the River Clyde, Glasgow has rich and troubled industrial history, mostly focussed on the ship-building industry. Architectural and artistic highlights in Glasgow include the Kelvingrove Museum, Glasgow Cathedral, the legacy of Charles Rennie Mackintosh and the recently reopened Burrell Collection in Pollock Park, said to be the greatest art gift ever given to a city. The Wednesday evening drinks reception will be held in the magnificent city chambers on George Square. The Thursday conference dinner will be held at the Kelvingrove Museum, which will be celebrating its 125th anniversary in 2026.

Modern Glasgow is renowned for its vibrant music scene and is a UNESCO City of Music. Our conference will take place in the modern Technology and Innovation Centre (TIC) at the University of Strathclyde, right in the heart of the city, a short walk from the cathedral, the city chambers and the two train stations. There are many excellent restaurants and comfortable hotels very close to the venue.

HOW DOES THE HYBRID CONFERENCE WORK?

This hybrid event will combine both in-person and virtual experiences, allowing for more people to attend. The conference will be delivered both physically to a maximum of 450 in person attendees in Glasgow and additionally anyone else who would like to join online via our conference app platform. In Oxford for the BPNA 2025 Conference, we welcomed more than 800 attendees physically and online via our virtual platform.

The physical conference will give you the opportunity to engage with the UK paediatric neurology community face-to-face and via the virtual side of the conference, which will continue to provide a rich environment for all participants, exhibitors, presenters, and chairs. Both physical and virtual delegates will use the conference app platform to navigate themselves around the conference, view the programme, posters, and meet exhibitors. Our conference environment provides a fully searchable programme with biographies of presenters and chairs, abstracts of presentations, posters, and other event information. The conference is accessible via computer, phone and iPad.

The virtual stand space for exhibitors will still be fully accessible to all conference attendees and enable a group chat for whoever visits the page. You have the opportunity to include other elements such as contact details, slideshows, flyers and video links via your dedicated virtual stand page. You will be able to schedule one-to-one meetings with attendees online. Sponsorship opportunities are available for both virtual and physical stand space.

SPONSORED SYMPOSIA

Price: £11,500 + VAT

We invite proposals for sponsored symposia sessions at BPNA 2026. This is a competitive process with the BPNA Research committee selecting the symposia proposals that it considers having the most educational value for attendees. Limited number available. Proposals will be selected by the BPNA Research Committee, which also scores and selects conference abstracts.

The symposia sessions form part of the conference programme and are open to all attendees. Each session will be 45-minutes and are available on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. This year we will be continuing delegate badge scanning at the physical conference which will allow you to get a full report on the number of delegates that attended the symposia session in-person as well as online.

Symposia must be of educational value and in accordance with the BPNA charitable aims. The programme must focus on an educational theme. Before writing your proposal, we would encourage you read the BPNA's charitable aims and our ethics, values and principles (available at <https://www.bpna.org.uk/?page=about-us>) to ensure your proposal meets these.

The closing date for applications is **1 September 2025**. You will be notified if you have been successful by the 6 October 2025.

VIRTUAL STAND SPACE
