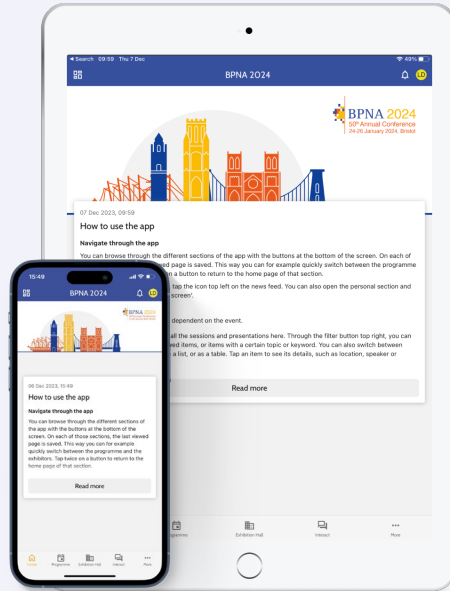

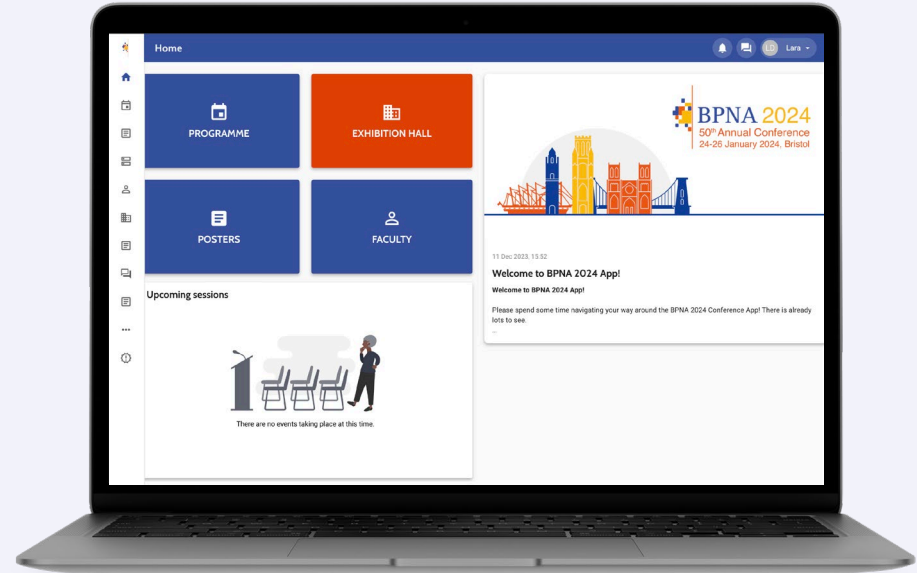
# Introduction to BPNA Mobile App and Web App



# Downloading the mobile app and accessing the web app



Search for **BPNA** in the App Store (iPhone, iPad) or Play Store (Android) and install the app. Not available for Blackberry or Windows Phones.

# Signing in

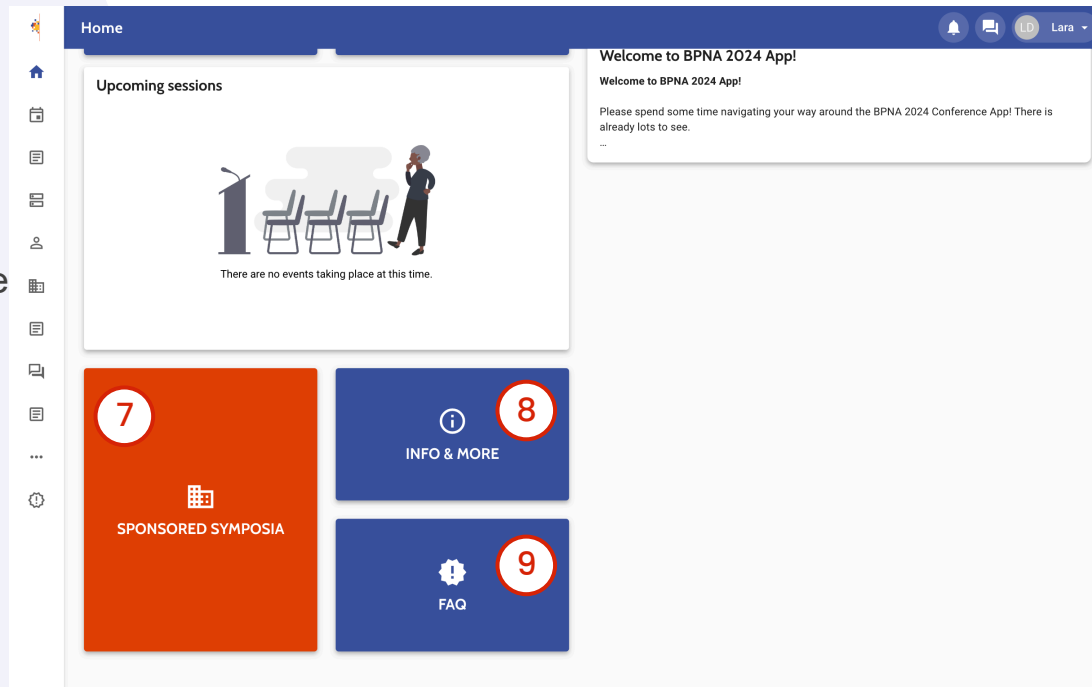

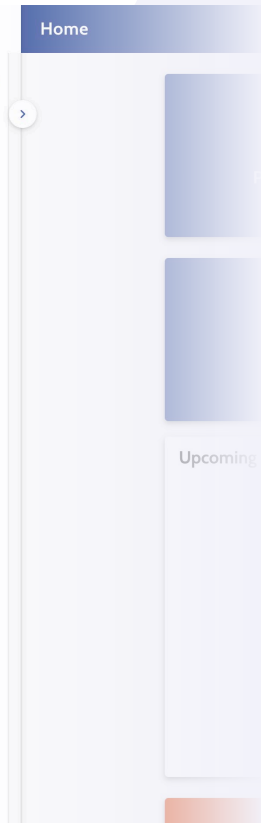
# Web app side menu

Access the information displayed on the home page also through the **Side Menu**

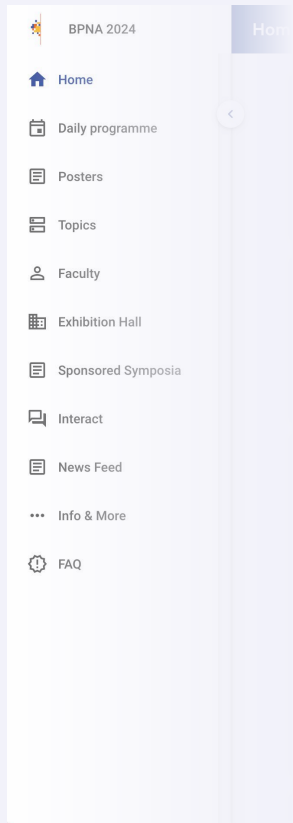

## Web app side menu

**1:** The side menu will be identified by the set of icons. To expand it, hover over the menu to see the arrow pointing to the right and click on it.

**2:** The expanded side menu contains not just the icons, but full names of the pages you can access. To hide it again, click the arrow pointing to the left.

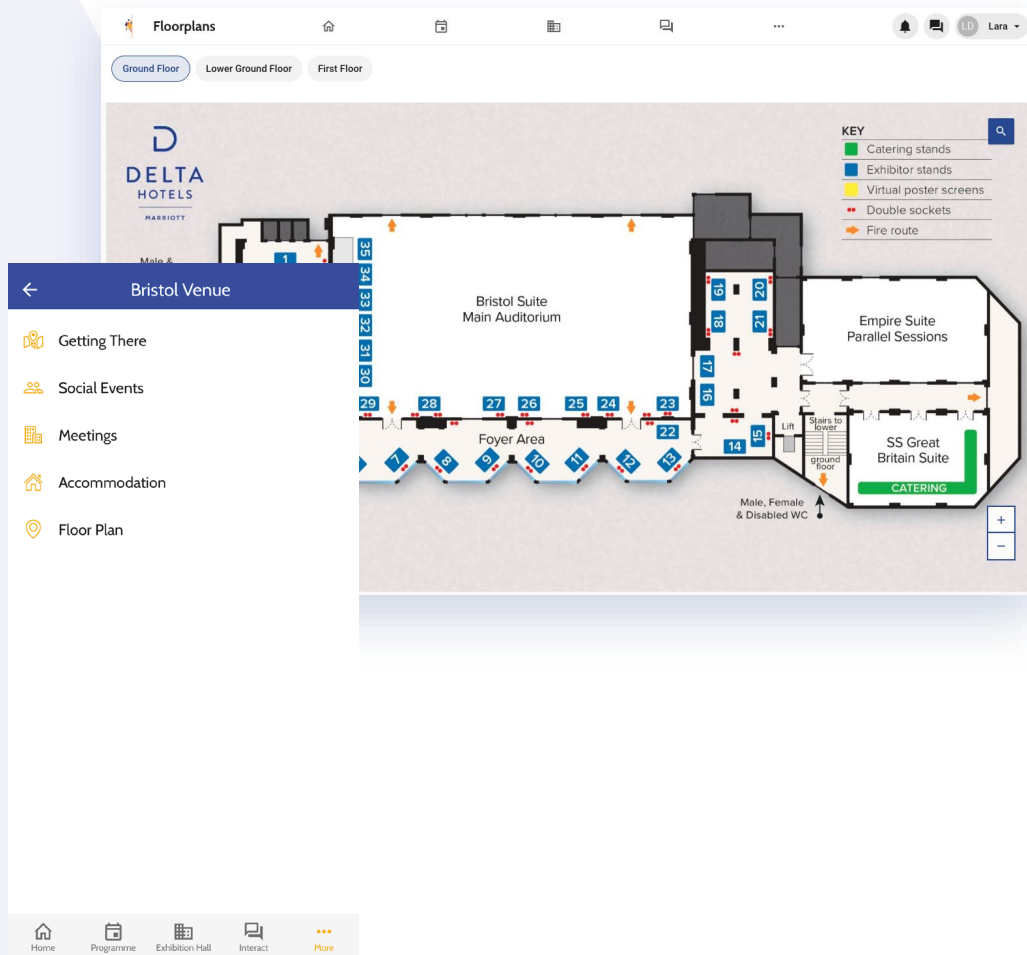


# Floor Plan

To view the Floor Plan in the mobile app, go to More, click on **Bristol Venue** and then on **Floor Plan**

To view the Floor Plan in the web app, simply click on **Floorplans**.

You can switch between each floor plan by clicking on the respective “Ground Floor”, “Lower Ground Floor”, or “First Floor” button.



# View Live Sessions

To view sessions live, go to **Programme** and click on the session you would like to view.

Access the session by clicking **Enter Virtual Room** button. This will take you through a WebEx webinar waiting room.

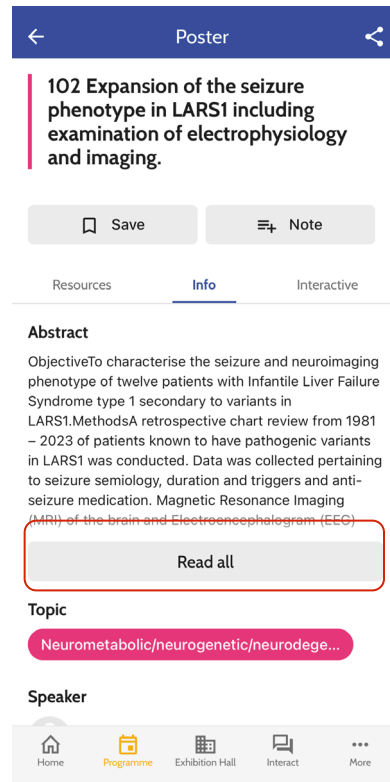
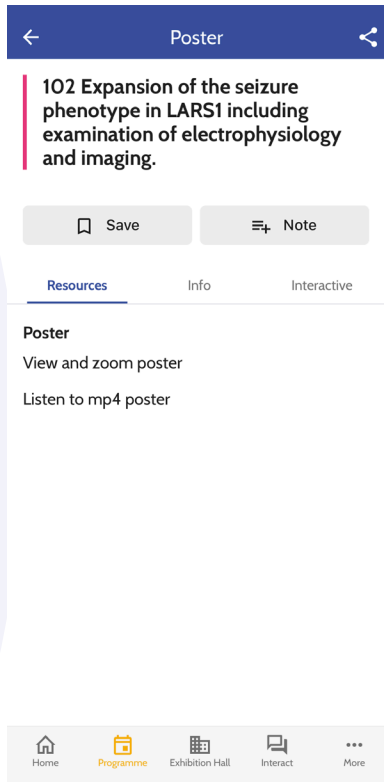
Click the poster you are interested in to find out more about it, such as who the presenters are.

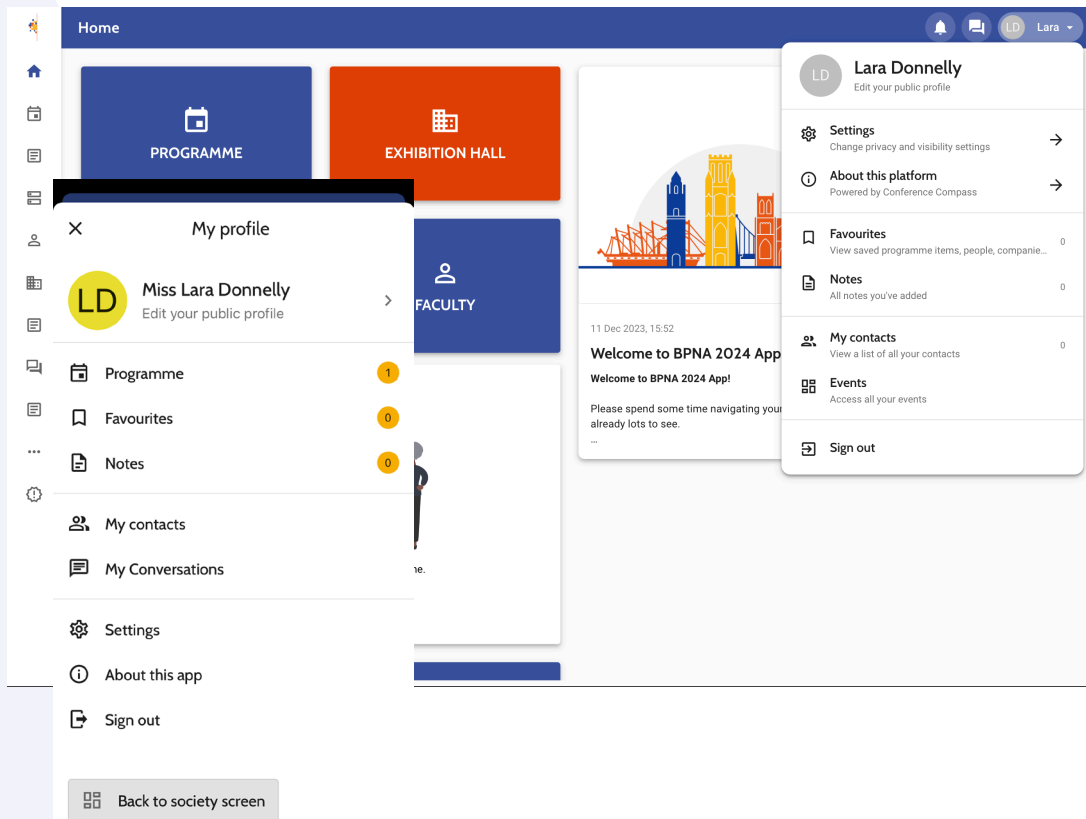

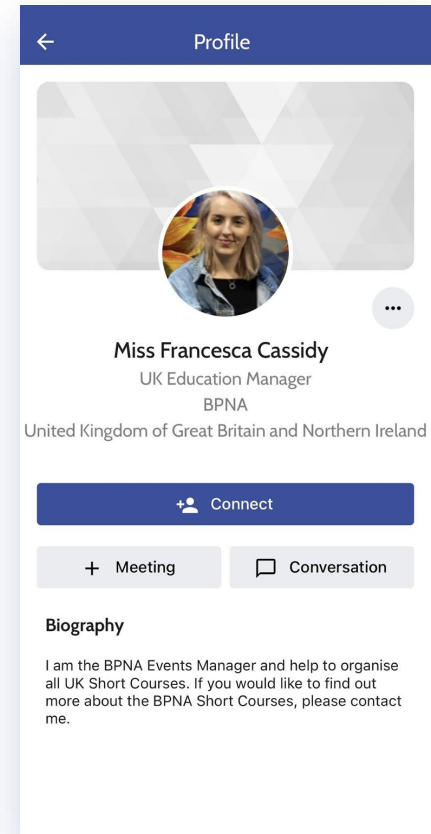
