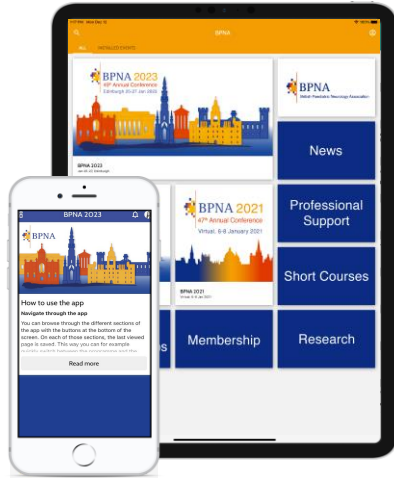




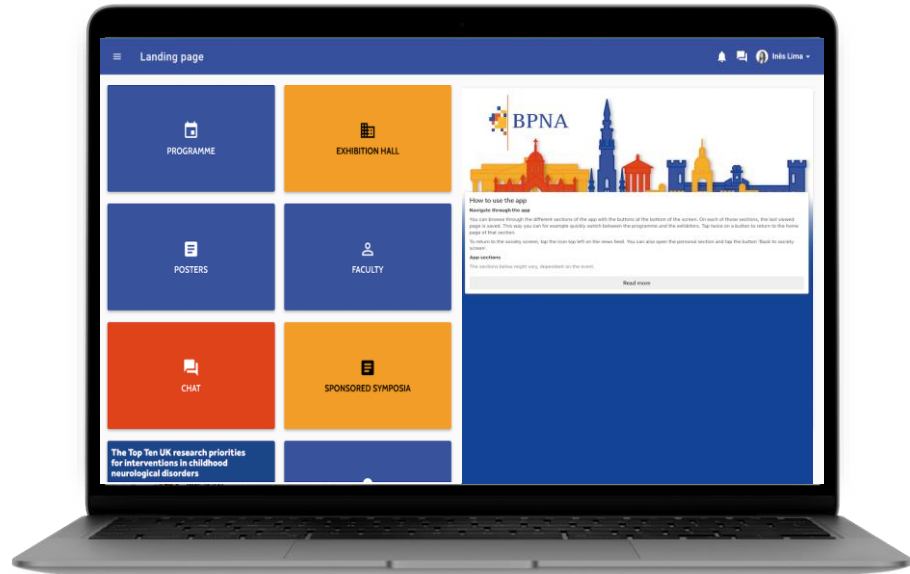
# Introduction to BPNA Mobile App and Web App



# Downloading the mobile app and accessing the web app



Search for **BPNA** in the App Store (iPhone, iPad) or Play Store (Android) and install the app. Not available for Blackberry or Windows Phones.



The App is also available on a desktop version. Visit <https://bpna.flog.live/event/bpna2023> to access the Web App on your Chrome browser.



# Signing in

To **install the event on the mobile app** and **to access the webapp**, sign in with your BPNA Login credentials.

By signing in, you will have a personal profile, allowing you to **access the sessions**, **interact with other attendees** and **schedule one-to-one appointments**.

Once signed in, your favourites, notes and other personal content **will be synced between your mobile devices and webapp**.

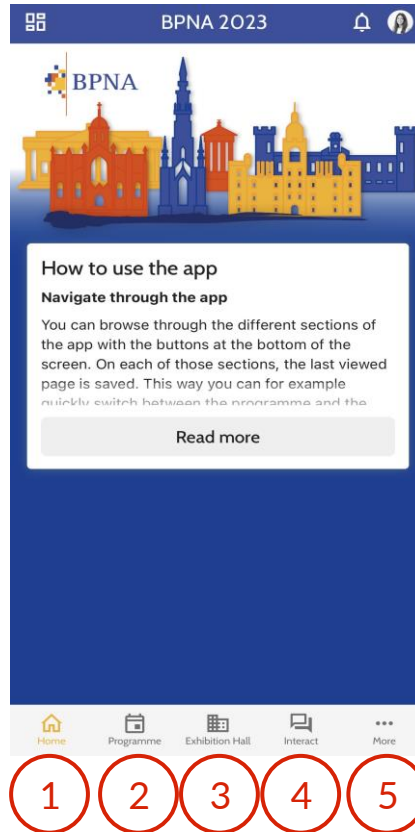

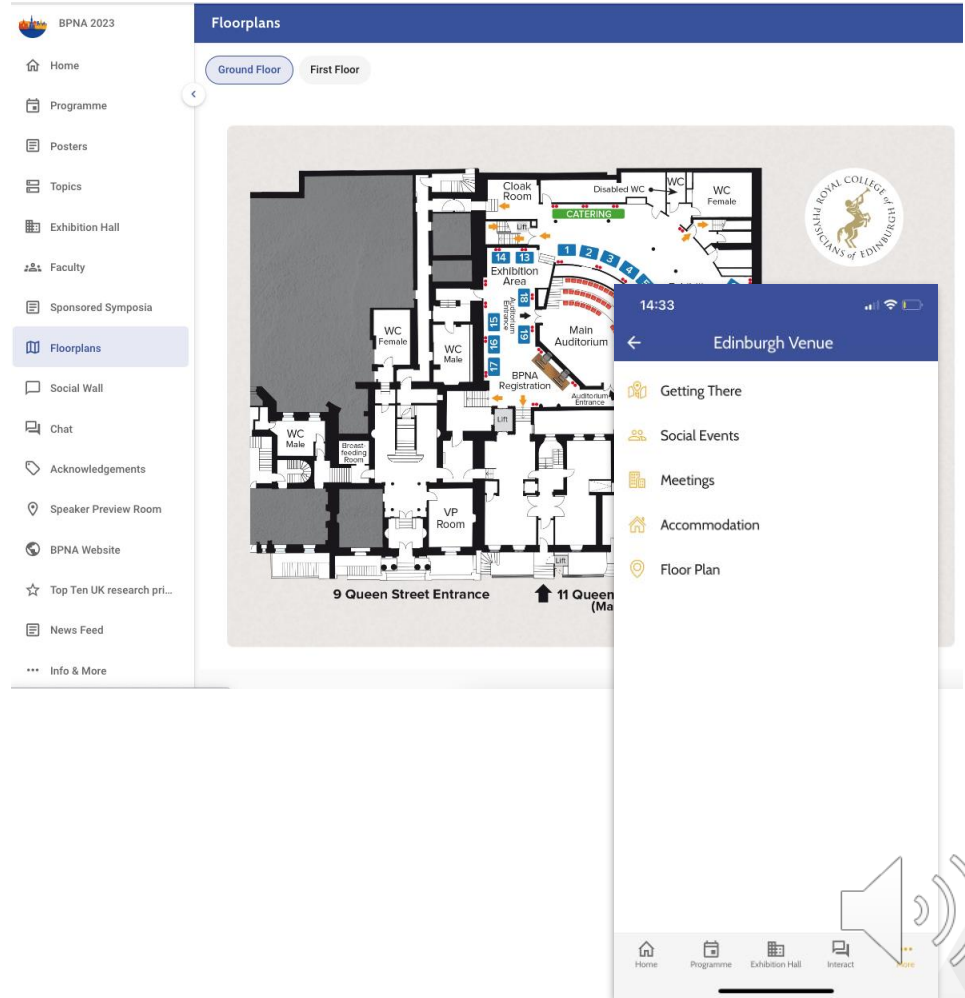


# Floor Plan

To view the Floor Plan in the mobile app, go to More, click on **Edinburgh Venue** and then on **Floor Plan**.

To view the Floor Plan in the web app, simply click on **Floorplans**.

You can switch between each floor plan by clicking on the respective “Ground Floor” or “First Floor” button.





# View Live Sessions

To view sessions live, go to **Programme** and click on the session you would like to view.

Access the session by clicking **Enter Virtual Room** button. This will take you through a WebEx webinar waiting room.

# Abstracts and Posters

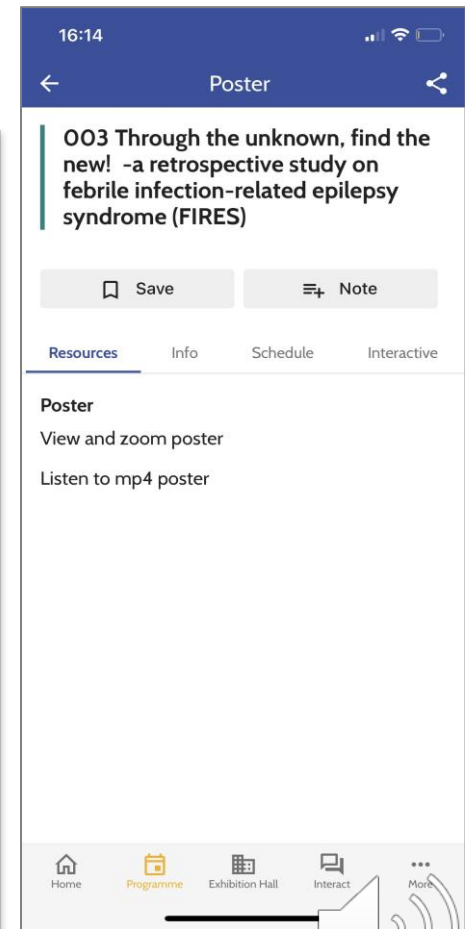
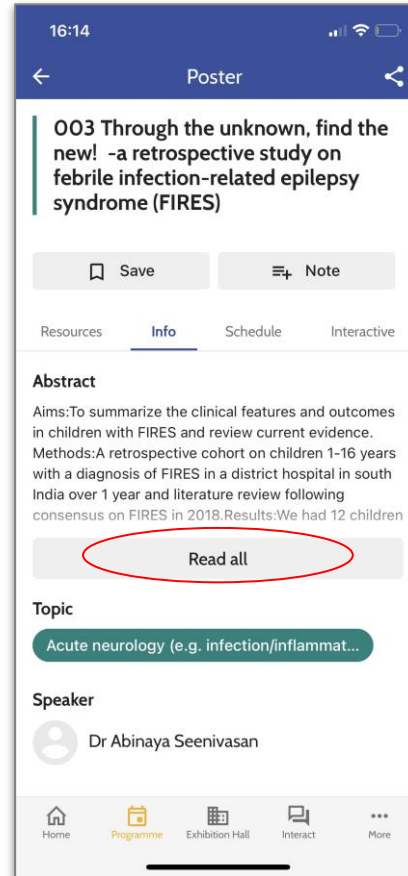
Click the poster you are interested in to find out more about it, such as who the presenters are.

Click on **Interactive** to ask the presenter a question.

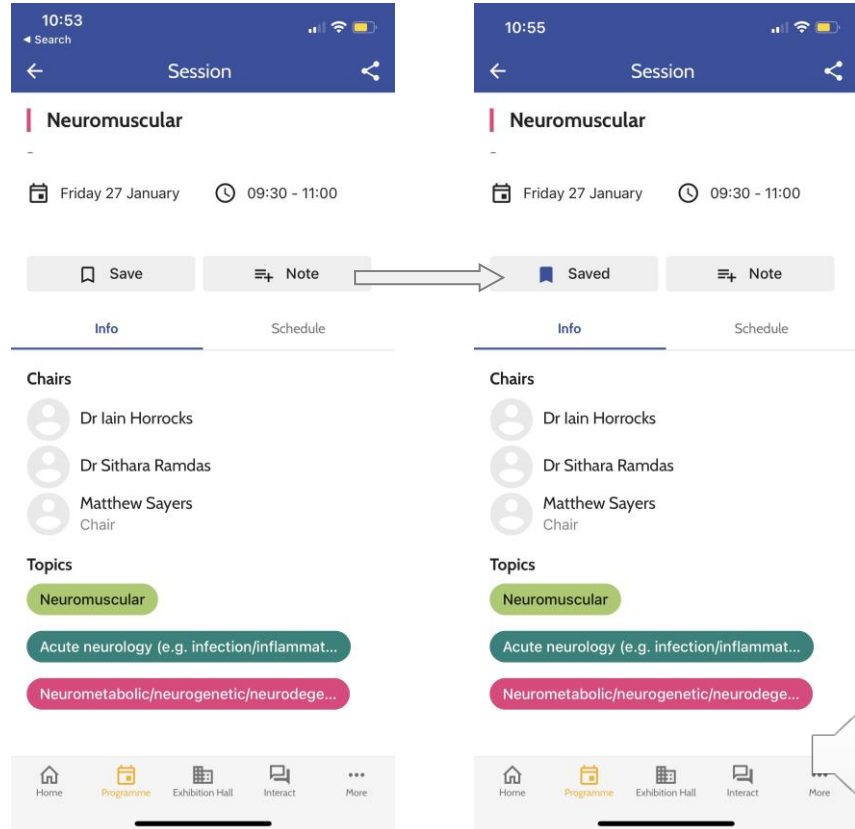
On the **Save and Note** buttons, you can save the posters and make notes of your choice.

Tap the **Save icon** to save items for later reference.

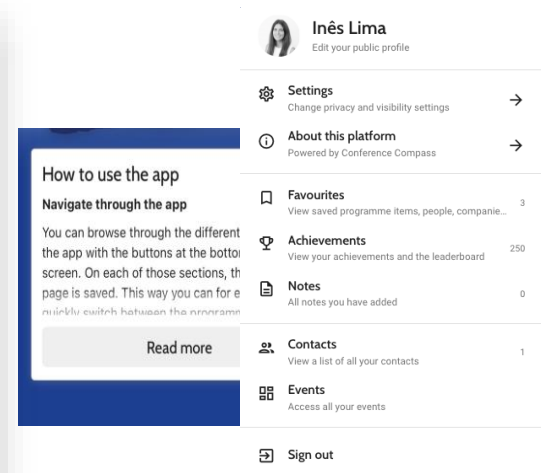
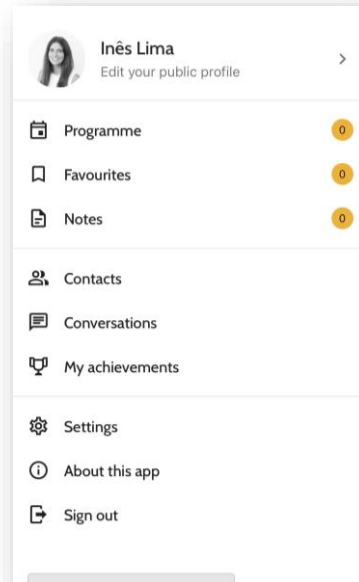
Click the **Create Note** icon to add a note for an item.

Access your saved items through **My Profile**, accessible on the top right corner of the mobile app or on the **profile menu of the webapp**.

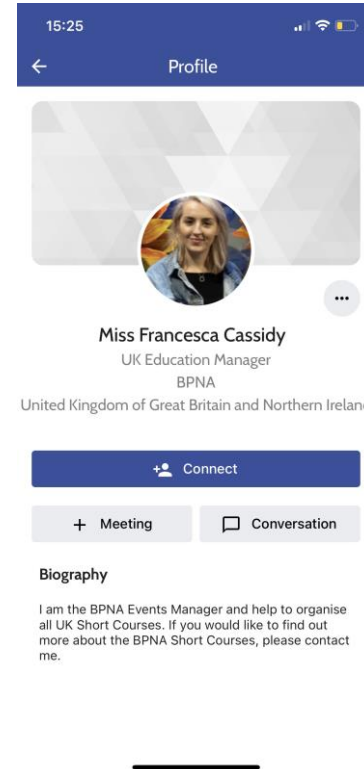


# Interact with other attendees

In the **profile** of another attendee, you can:

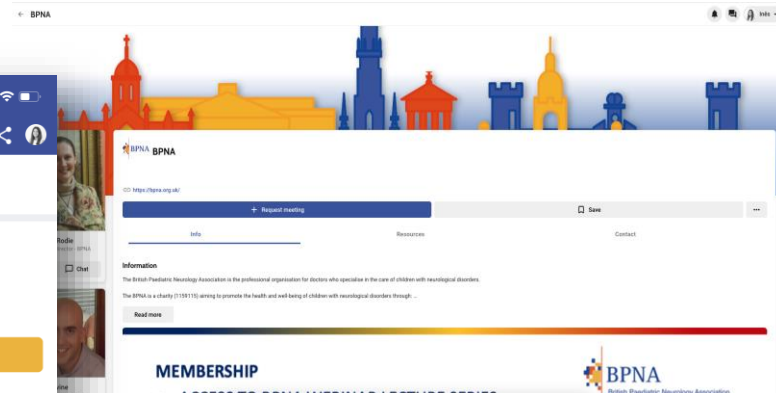
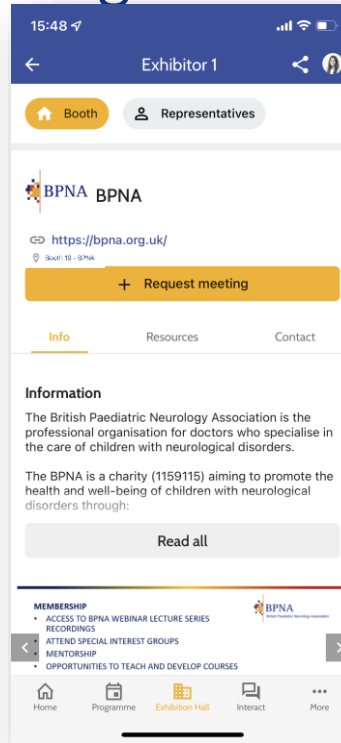
- Start a conversation

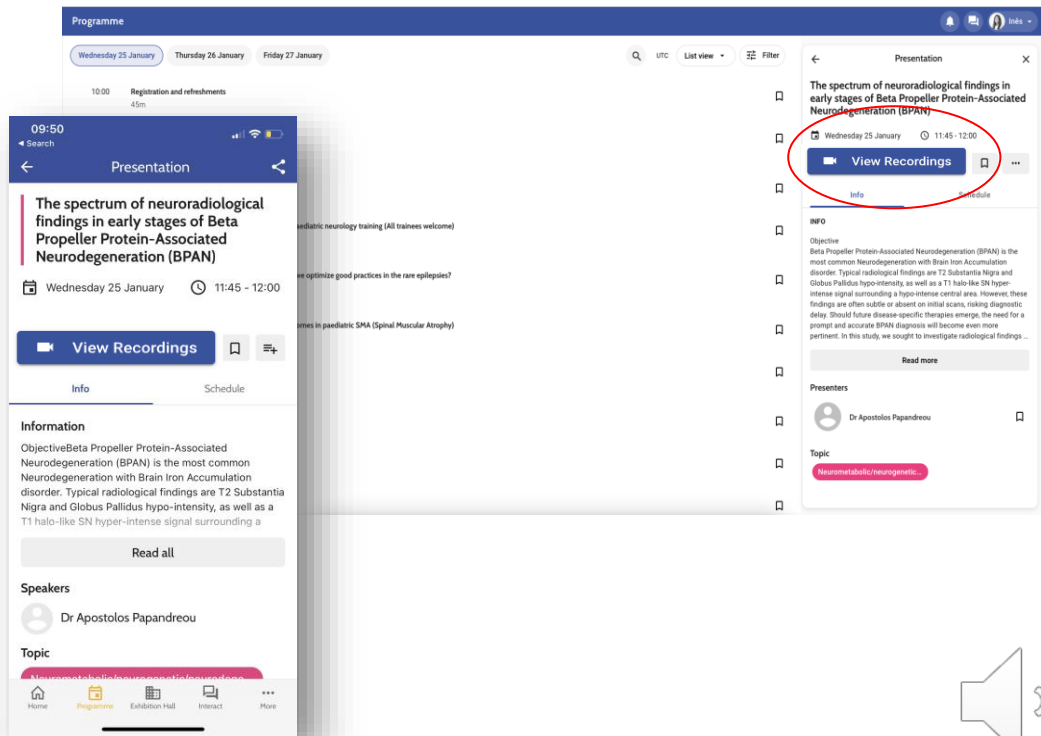


# View on-demand recordings
